

Retro Reminders

Retroactive pay is only for:

- journeypeople
- whose contracts expired before ratification
- and who were employed both at the time of ratification AND the time of the retro checks being issued.

Many of you will have received your checks by the time you get this newspaper in the mail. For those of you who haven't, please continue to be patient. There are nearly one hundred contracts for employer payroll departments to work their way through, and they appear to be tackling this process by contract expiration date. (In other words, those whose contracts expired first are seeing their retro checks first.) You do NOT lose any money while you wait - the retro will apply from the time of your contract expiration up through the time your raises take place.

- I will remain silent, and I refuse to answer your questions.
- If I am detained, I have the right to contact an attorney immediately.

REMINDER! You have the right to:

Talk about Negotiations

1-800-452-8329. YOUR UNION WILL PROTECT YOUR RIGHTS.

If you are allowed to talk about any other non-work related topics at work, you are allowed to talk about negotiations or other union activities with your co-workers. If customers ask you about negotiations you are allowed to answer questions.

Wear a Button

Your right to wear a union button is protected union activity under federal law.

Sign a Petition

You are allowed to engage in union activity like signing petitions in your workplace as long as the time and place is reasonable.

Read, Distribute, Discuss Union Literature Just like signing a petition, you are allowed to do these union activities at work.

Take Actions Outside your Store and in the Community

You can participate in actions in front of your store and engage with the community when you are off the clock.

IT IS ILLEGAL FOR THE EMPLOYER TO DISCIPLINE YOU, CUT YOUR HOURS, REASSIGN YOU, OR RETALIATE AGAINST YOU FOR PARTICIPATING IN UNION ACTIVITIES. IF A MANAGER TELLS YOU TO TAKE OFF A BUTTON OR STOP TALKING ABOUT THE UNION, DO WHAT THEY SAY. THEN, CALL YOUR UNION REP AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AT
